Last chance to have MACRAO awarded by a community college is summer 2019. Universities will continue to accept MACRAO if it is already on a transcript.

Other MTA Requirements

- 1. Grade of 2.0 required in each course
- Refer to community colleges for approved course lists
 Course lists are available on community college websites. Links are available on our website http://www.emich.edu/ccr/trackingsystem/MTAdirectlinks.php
- 3. Students must have their transcripts evaluated and endorsed as "MTA Satisfied" by a community college. Some colleges have an online form to apply for an MTA audit.
- 4. Minimum of one course must be taken at a community college to request an audit.

Other MACRAO Requirements

- 1. Some community colleges require a grade of 2.0 in each course others do not.
- 2. Some community colleges have printed lists of approved courses. Some do not
- 3. Students must have their transcripts evaluated and endorsed as "MACRAO Satisfied" by a community college. Some colleges have an online form to apply for a MACRAO audit.
- 4. Most community colleges have a residency requirement for MACRAO (7 credits to 20 credits)
