She was diagnosed with breast cancer at age 35, and she faced domestic violence. Despite all that, she remained the light of her community and a servant to others. With this scholarship, Mr. Jordan and his wife Sherri Jordan ('83) honor Beatrice Cozetta Jordan by helping those who have faced similar challenges achieve their purpose in life. One award of \$1000 is given annually, distributed across the fall and winter semesters.
